Hi Dumont's-one and all:

Well, here we go again. I just finished a book "INTO OBLIVION" by Robert L. Bunting and it was quite a book. It was about the town of Alcona and a ship that was lost off Alcona by fire. The ship was the Marine City, and an all wood ship and it caught fire shortly after departing Alcona for Detroit, and many were lost.

The town of Alcona was a lumberman town and burned in 1893 and the population dwindled after the fire as the lumber workers moved inland to start farms or moved south looking for work.
